English Afternoon Tea Event

Event date: Saturday, April 30, 2016

- Tickets are available only through Eventbrite. Ticket price: \$20.00
- Event location: Mr. & Mrs. John Walker's home: 1040 Arbor Road
- This is an outdoor event: tea will be held in the pool courtyard area. (If there is inclement weather, the event will be moved inside)
- Seatings at noon & 1:15 (50 people each seating)
When these seatings are full, we will open two more seatings 2:30 & 3:45
- Guests may park on the front cobblestone driveway of the Walker home (please enter driveway at the 1st entrance closest to Reynolda Rd) Park on the left side of the driveway; all cars facing the same direction. This will make it easy for guests to enter & exit. Please carpool if at all possible.
- You may also park along Arbor Road.
- Walk to the end of the cobblestone driveway (by the mailbox) where it meets the paved back driveway. Follow the paved driveway around to the back of the property to the pool courtyard area. There will be a greeter to direct you.

- Please arrive at least 5 minutes prior to your seating time, so you may be seated as quickly as possible. We will try to seat you with others in your party if at all possible.
- The allotted time for each seating is one hour.
- The food will be plated. We will not be able to make any substitutions or accommodate food allergies or dietary restrictions. Please see the menu below.
- For your safety, please note that you may need to walk across uneven cobblestones on the driveway. Also, the entire area of the pool courtyard is pea gravel.
- The Garden Tour and English Afternoon Tea require separate tickets. If you would like to attend both events, please make sure that you purchase both tickets.
